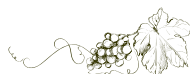

290. Hudson & Co. Jr/Am 3'3" \$40

To be shown over a course of Hunter/Jumper type fences approx. 3'3", with flat work incorporated into the course. NO work-off is required, but further testing is at the judge's discretion. Points awarded to the top 8 riders (8-7-6-5-4-3-2-1) points will be doubled in classes with 15 or more. Eight points required to qualify a rider for Finals. Five riders must complete the course.

291. NorCal Jr. 3'6" \$40

Open to Junior members of NorCal. Trainers of contestants must also be members. To be shown over a course of not less than 8 fences 3'6" in height. See specs in NorCal rule book.

292. NorCal Sr. 3'6" \$40

Open to Amateur members of NorCal. See Jr. Medal specs.

293. NorCal Pony 2'3/2'6'3' \$40

Open to current junior members of the NorCal Hunter Jumper Association. Trainers of contestants must also be members of NorCal. No Jr. over 12 years may compete on a sm. pony, and no Jr. over 14 years may compete on a med. pony. Riders in this class may not enter a NorCal Junior Medal class at the same show. Fence heights will be according to USEF specifications for sm., med. and lrg ponies. Course will incorporate a work-off of at least two tests. 5 riders must complete the course. One rider per pony.

294. NorCal 3' 3' \$40

May be offered in the Hunter or Jumper ring. Open to all juniors and amateurs who have not won a 3'6" medal in the preceding 5 years and who are not showing 3'6" or higher at this show. Trainers of competitors must also be members.

295. Almaden Farms Jr/Am Medal 2'9" \$40

Open to Jr/Am riders. To be shown over a course of Hunter or Jumper fences. Course must include a combination; two changes of direction and two tests will be incorporated in the course. At least three riders must enter and two riders must complete. Free entry to Finals.

296. WCC Jr/Am 3'3" \$40

To be shown over a minimum of 8 fences 3'3" with 2 changes of direction and one combination which must include an oxer. 2 or more tests will be incorporated in the original course, and no work-off is required. At least 4 riders must finish.

297. Cloverleaf Medal 3'0" \$40

Class is open to Junior & Amateur riders not showing in any classes over 3'6 in height. To be judged over a Jumper course of not less than 9 fences at 3 feet in height. To be judged on hands, seat, guidance & control of the horse on a Jumper type of ride. There will not be a time allowed; a

tone will be used to signal the rider to start the course. Any Jumper type bit or equipment is allowed. Jumping penalties will be considered in accordance with USEF Equitation rules. Additional work-offs after the initial round will be at the Judge's discretion, and any number of riders may be asked to test. At least 3 riders must enter & show in the class. First & second place winners will be qualified for the finals. Winner of the finals will receive an Antares saddle & a cooler, Second place a bridle & prizes to 8th place. Finals October 7-10, 2010 at Brookside Equestrian Park.

298. Horse & Hound Jr/Am Medal 3' \$40

Open to all junior and amateur riders who have not competed in a 3'6" medal finals in the previous 3 years and who are not showing 3'6" or higher at this show. To be shown over a hunter or jumper course of 3' fences with 2 tests included. 5 riders fill. Points awarded 7-5-4-3-2-1. If only 4 finish, points will be awarded 5-3-2-1. 5 points qualifies for the finals in Oct. Classes with 15 or more entries will be pointed 10-8-7-6-5-4-3-2.

299. Horse & Hound Pony Medal \$40

Minimum 6 fences, Two USEF tests 1-9 in course, No Work off.

300. PCHA Jr. 14 & Under 3'3" \$40

This class is designed as an intermediate equitation class for riders 14 years of age and under who are current PCHA members. See further specs in PCHA rule book.

301. PCHA Adult 35 & Over 3'3" \$40

This class is open to riders 35 years of age and over (horse show age) who are current PCHA members. See further specs in PCHA rule book.

302. Onondarka 12 & Under 3' \$40

For riders 12 years of age and under, current members of the PCHA, who will not be older than 12 (USEF horse show age) when Final is held. Three (3) contestants must complete the course in order for points to count. See further specs in PCHA rule book.

303. Foxfield 18 & Over 3'3" \$40

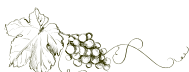
Open to amateur members of PCHA. See specs in PCHA rule book.

304. Christensen's Jr/Am Medal 3'3" \$40

Two or more tests within the course. No work off is required.

305. Pickwick Jr/Am 3'3" \$40

To be shown over a jumper course of not less than 8 fences 3'3" in height. To be judged on hands, seat, guidance & control of the horse. Jumper type horses are encouraged



& jumper equip. is allowed. Jumping penalties are to be considered in accordance with USEF hunter seat equitation rules. There will be no work-off. A time allowed of 382ypp/350mpm will be used. One point deducted from score for each second over posted time allowed. At least 5 riders must start the class and points will be awarded 7-5-4-3-2-1. If only 4 finish, points will be 5-3-2-1. Classes with 15 or more will be pointed 10-8-7-6-5-4-3-2. 7 points qualifies for the finals in Sept. Gold, Silver & Bronze medals will be awarded to the top 3 in each qualifying class.

306. Equisport Insurance/USEF Pony Medal 2'3/2'6/3' \$40

Open to junior members of USEF who have not reached 18th birthday on ponies 14.2 hands under. Riders in this class cannot cross enter the USEF Jr. Medal at same show. Two tests included in the course. For class to count six riders must complete the course.

307. Pessoa/USEF Junior Medal 3'6' \$40

Open to junior members of USEF. Fences 3'6". Two or more tests of top 4 required. For class to count, 6 riders must complete the course. See specs in USEF rule book.

308. USEF Adult Equitation 3'3' \$40

Open to Amateur Members of the USEF. To be shown over a course of not less than eight obstacles at 3'3". Two or more tests of the top four competitors are required. To fill a class six competitors must complete the course. Only one rider per horse. See specs in USEF rule book.

309. Art Gottfried Medal 2'9' \$40

Open to Jr. and Am. riders 85 & under not showing in medal classes of 3'6" or higher. Individual testing optional at the Judge's discretion.

310. SAHJA Pony Medal  2'3' \$40

Open to Junior riders showing ponies (14.2 hands and under). To be judged over a course of fences ranging from 2'0" to 2'6" in height, with two USEF tests (1-9) incorporated in the course. There is no work-off. Open scoring must be used. Points awarded based on number of riders in the class. Five points to qualify for finals.

311. SAHJA Mini Medal  2'6' \$40

Open to any Junior or Amateur rider who has not won a rated 3'6" medal class or any medal finals, except the SAHJA Pony Medal. Riders to be judged over a course of fences 2'6" in height, with at least two USEF tests (1-19) incorporated into the course. There is no work-off. Open scoring must be used. Points awarded based on number of riders in the class. Five points to qualify for finals.

312. SAHJA Child/Adult Medal  3' \$40

Open to any Junior or Amateur rider. Riders to be judged over a course of fences 3'0" in height. At least the top four will return for a flat work-off. Open scoring must be used. Points awarded based on number of riders in the class. Five points to qualify for finals.

313. CPHA Junior Hunter Seat Medal Class - 17 And Under:

Open to junior riders, seventeen (17) years of age and under, who are current registered members of the California Professional Horsemen's Association and the PCHA. (Trainers of riders in this class must be professional members of the CPHA and PCHA.) To be shown over either a hunter or jumper equitation type course of fences 3'6" in height with at least two (2) changes of direction and at least (1) combination with a spread fence. A minimum of three (3) riders will be required to work off using (USEF Eq. Tests 1-18).

314. CPHA Amateur Hunter Seat Medal Class - 18 & Over

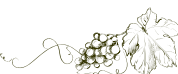
Open to amateur riders, eighteen (18) years of age and over, who are current registered members of the California Professional Horsemen's Association and the PCHA. (Trainers of riders in this class must be professional members of the CPHA and PCHA.) Same specs as the CPHA Junior Hunt Seat Medal Class 17 and under.

315. CPHA Foundation Equitation

Open to Junior and Amateur riders who are current members of the CPHA and PCHA, to be judged over an equitation type course of at least 8 fences 3'3" in height with at least 2 USEF Tests (1, 2,6,10,12,15,17 or 18) included as part of the course. Trainers of riders in this class must be professional members of the CPHA and current members of the PCHA. This class will be judged on the current standards of the US Equestrian Federation.

316. WCE MEDAL

Open to current CPHA and PCHA Junior and Amateur members whose trainers are also current members of the CPHA and PCHA. At least three (3) riders must complete the course for the class to receive points. This class is designed as a jumper type equitation class, held in the jumper ring over a jumper course at 1.10m (3'7") with spreads from 1.10m to 1.25m (3'7" - 4'1"). The class will be judged under a modified power and speed format (Table II, Sec 2(c)), with no time allowed for the power phase and a 375 meters/minute time allowed for the speed phase. Horses will continue on to the speed phase regardless of knockdowns or a refusal. A second refusal will eliminate. Time allowed is an important factor in this class and it may only be changed by the course designer if he thinks a gross error was made in his original calculation. However, the time allowed may only be adjusted once during the early rounds of a given competition, never later than after the third competitor to complete the course without a disobedience or if any of the first three take more than 45 seconds to cross the start line. (In 2014 if the qualifying class is accidentally run as a Table II class before June 2, the qualifying points will still count.) Stallions are allowed per USEF jumper division rules. A jumper type horse with jumper equipment is allowed and will not be penalized. No draw reins or German martingales allowed. However, standing and running martingales are permitted.

RULES & GENERAL INFORMATION

1. EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES & SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED & JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.

2. LIFE, SENIOR ACTIVE AND JUNIOR ACTIVE MEMBERS SHALL BE ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN ALL CLASSES AT REGULAR COMPETITIONS, EVENTING COMPETITIONS AT THE PRELIMINARY LEVEL OR ABOVE AND COMBINED DRIVING COMPETITIONS AT THE ADVANCED LEVEL, DRESSAGE, REINING AND VAULTING COMPETITIONS AND ENDURANCE RIDES. A NONMEMBER MAY PARTICIPATE AS A HANDLER, RIDER, DRIVER, OWNER, LESSEE, AGENT, COACH OR TRAINER AT REGULAR COMPETITIONS, EVENTING COMPETITIONS, DRESSAGE COMPETITIONS, REINING COMPETITIONS AND COMBINED DRIVING COMPETITIONS UPON PAYMENT OF A \$30 NONMEMBER REGISTRATION FEE. PARTICIPANTS IN THE FOLLOWING CLASSES ARE EXEMPTED FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS RULE: 1) LEADLINE; 2) EXHIBITIONS; 3) GAMES AND RACES; 4) CLASSES FOR 4-H MEMBERS; 5) WALK TROT AND ACADEMY CLASSES (ACADEMY CLASSES ARE CLASSES LIMITED TO HORSES USED REGULARLY IN A LESSON PROGRAM); 6) USDF INTRODUCTORY LEVEL TESTS, PAS DE DEUX AND QUADRILLE CLASSES; 7) NRHA ENDORSED REINING COMPETITIONS. 8) OPPORTUNITY CLASSES, 9) CITIZENS OF OTHER NATIONS WHO HAVE PROOF, IN ENGLISH, OF CURRENT MEMBERSHIP IN GOOD STANDING OF THEIR OWN NATIONAL FEDERATION, 10) USEA BEGINNER NOVICE DIVISION; AND 11) ASSISTANT HANDLERS IN DRESSAGE SPORT HORSE BREEDING CLASSES.

3. **ENTRY PROCEDURE:** For each horse entered send a \$35 Entry Deposit Fee, plus fees for any stalls/tack rooms requested. Send with your completed entry blank on or before the closing date. If entries are post-marked not later than the closing date and are properly filled out, the \$35 will be credited towards your entries.

The entry form MUST include:

Horses name and complete description.

All divisions or classes entered.

All mandatory signatures, including legal guardian in the case of a minor exhibitor.

Organization membership numbers - non-member fees will be assessed if membership numbers are not listed.

Social Security numbers must be listed on the entry form before prize money will be paid

****Online entries MUST have a deposit check postmarked by or before the closing date of entries.**

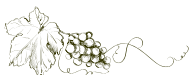
No entries will be accepted without a check, nor by facsimile, nor by E mail, nor with any form of hand cancelled postage. Online entries require deposit check postmarked by the closing date of entries. Any entry not meeting these criteria, or whose check is non-negotiable for any reason, will be returned with no status in the entry procedure. It is the responsibility of the entrant or their agent to adhere to these policies.

4. **LATE ENTRIES:** Entries postmarked after the closing date will be assessed a \$35 late fee. **This deadline will be strictly enforced.** The post office official date of cancellation will be the only evidence allowable for charging late fees. No hand canceled or metered mail marking will be accepted. **No Exceptions. Entries will not be accepted by facsimile or E mail.** If there is a local delay specific to your city or county, please plan to mail your entries early to avoid a late fee. Post entries will be accepted with a processing fee of \$5.00 per class.

5. **POST ENTRIES:** Entries made or classes added at the show will be considered "Post Entries". **Post entries may be limited or not accepted based on show schedule.** It is to your distinct advantage to enter all the classes that you expect to ride in on your original entry. Substitutions & class changes will be treated as post entries

6. **REFUNDS:** Before the closing date of entries full refunds will be given. After the closing date, with a Veterinarian's or doctor's certificate, full refunds will be given less a \$35 office charge, and less fees for classes held prior to notification at the Horse Show Office, whether exhibited in or not. During the show, only the show Veterinarian's report will be accepted. Stall deposits will be refunded if canceled by July 24, 2014.

7. **ADD / SCRATCHED CLASSES:** Adds and Scratches may be made at no extra charge prior to picking up your number. After picking up your number, any scratches made the day before the class takes place,



will receive full refund. Same day scratches will be charged \$5 scratch fee. Same day adds will be charged a \$5 add fee, all Adds & Scratches need to be done in the office prior to the class starting. No credit will be given for classes not scratched prior to the beginning of the class entered. Exhibitors competing in a class without first entering at the horse show office will pay a \$15.00 penalty in addition to the Entry Fee. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to notify the office. Adding a class at the back gate does not relieve you from completing the paperwork in the office.

8. CONDITION OF ENTRY: Every horse entered for competition will be under the control of the Horse Show Management, but management will, in no case, be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the Horse Show, its directors and employees, MDC Corporation, and Brookside Equestrians, Inc harmless for any loss or accident to his horse(s) or equipment which may occur from sickness, fire or otherwise.

9. MINOR EXHIBITORS: Parent(s) or guardian(s) of minor exhibitors shall hold Horse Show Management and the Facility harmless for any injury to such minor. No child's entry will be accepted or number issued unless the entry is signed by a parent or LEGAL guardian.

10. PRIZES: Awards to 1st place in all classes, 1st - 8th to Open, Jr, Am, and Pony Hunters. 1st - 6th in all other classes. In all money classes prize money will be paid through 5th place with the money split 30%, 25%, 20%, 15%, 10%. Prize money will be made payable to the owner listed on the entry blank and mailed within 30 days. NO PRIZE MONEY WILL BE PAID UNLESS THE OWNER'S SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER IS LISTED ON THE ENTRY BLANK. NO PRIZE MONEY WILL BE PAID IF THERE IS INDEBTEDNESS OUTSTANDING. CHECKS MUST BE CASHED WITHIN 60 DAYS. In all classes with add-back, prize money is computed from the number of horses that actually show.

11. MANAGEMENT: The Horse Show Management reserves the right to interpret all questions & conditions in regard to or arising out of or incident to the show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. All questions not covered in these rules & regulations shall be decided by Horse Show Management, their decision to be final. The Horse Show Management reserves to itself the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify rider or exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries and cancel awards and prizes, without claim for damages; to cancel or combine any unfilled classes; to change rings or rotate judges; to change specifications in jumper classes in order to facilitate the time schedule. Management reserves the right to limit entries at its discretion.

12. STABLING: Stalls and tack rooms will be available for \$150 each. No bedding included. Stalls are of portable construction, 12' x 12' with top and bottom doors. A stall charge will be collected if stalls are used for any purpose ie: feed, camping, braiding, etc. Stalls will not be available prior to 8:00 AM, Wednesday, August 13th, unless specific arrangements are made with show management.

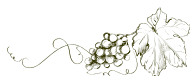
13. GROUNDS FEE: All horses entering the show and not using a stall will pay a \$40 per day grounds fee, used to offset facility costs, clean-up, and amenities.

14. FEED & BEDDING: Before the show, feed may be ordered directly from Brookside Equestrians, Inc. (916) 682-1403

15. RV PARKING: Please See RV Order form. Parking in RV lot ONLY. Before the show, RV reservations may be ordered directly from Brookside Equestrians Inc. (916) 682-1403

16. RETURNED CHECKS: Checks returned by the bank for any reason are regarded as a most serious offense and will be handled as follows: **ALL RETURNED CHECKS WILL BE CHARGED AN ADDITIONAL 10% PENALTY (\$50 MINIMUM).** Accounts will be given 10 days to be paid in full with cash or money order, or they will be turned in to the sanctioning organizations for further disciplinary action. If further action is needed, additional penalties will be incurred with a minimum of an additional \$50 or an additional 10% at management's discretion. Any exhibitor leaving the show with an unpaid balance of entry fees will be billed for these charges and a \$50 billing fee will be added to the total due.

17. UNSPORTSMANLIKE BEHAVIOR WILL NOT BE TOLERATED AND MANAGEMENT RESERVES THE RIGHT TO FILE CHARGES AND HOLD A SHOW COMMITTEE HEARING WHICH MAY RESULT IN FORFEITURE OF ALL ENTRIES, PRIZE MONEY AND RIBBONS.



18. SCHOOLING: Schooling will be allowed in all arenas on Wednesday at approximately 1:00 p.m. and at the end of each show day with time permitting. **NO SCHOOLING IN ARENAS AFTER COURSES HAVE BEEN SET FOR THE FOLLOWING DAY.** Mandatory schooling fee for all horses: \$30.

19. RINGS AND FOOTING: Arena 1 250x150', Sand Footing; Arena 2 290x150' - Sand Footing; Lower Arena 240x130' - Sand Footing; Grand Prix Arena 220x265' - Sand Footing

20. MOTORIZED VEHICLES: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a vehicle in violation of the rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

21. NON-SHOWING HORSES: For any horse on the grounds and not officially entered, owner or trainer of said horse must complete a "Not to Show" form, sign a release at the Horse Show Office, and pay a \$25 facility fee plus a \$30 schooling fee.
